Fun with Photoshop: lecture /demo/hands on

Using your own photographic images on Adobe Photoshop, you will create images that are truly your own. Learning the basics of Adobe Photoshop from an artistic point of view, students will learn to make dreamy surreal images, expressive self-portraits and apply special effects in Photoshop.

Class format:

The first half of class time will consist of demonstration & lecture where each student will follow along on computers; last half of class time will be hands-on lab time. Each student will receive a unique login to remember, in order to use a computer system for this 8-session class.

- ✓ Miss a class or fall behind? You will work on the buddy system. It will be important to team up with another student you trust and exchange contact information so you can stay on track.

◆ **Requirements**

- Have access to a camera or Smartphone.
- Have basic computer skills.
- Must be able to gain access to your own images; for example: know how to e-mail photos to yourself, and write to a flash drive to enable you to work on your own photographs in class.
- Back up all work on flash drive (supplied).
