### **Objective:**

- A) To discover the difference using flash makes on your photography.
- B) Create a Do It Yourself (DIY) flash modifier (diffuser) using supplies you have at home, or use a flash modifier you may already have on hand.
- C) Demonstrate the difference between 3 images of same subject:
  - 1) No flash
  - 2) With flash (no modifier)
  - 3) With flash – with modifier (DIY or store-bought)

*The subject can be of your choosing; can be food photography, a still life or a portrait - while arranging an interesting and strong composition with a clear focal point. Can be photographed inside or outside; experiment with different approaches and share your best flash comparison sequence.*
