Please upload how your best images for Macro photography – from the heart of your house, the kitchen! This can include household items, food, combining liquids (safety first) and experimenting.

- Upload: Your best image, then a photograph of your setup (you can use a Smartphone camera for that).

**Objective:** Create a new image – any subject you like – as long as it's from the kitchen. Challenge yourself with macro techniques, using the equipment you have. This class section presents varying methods you can use.

Technical challenges might include image sharpness: light will be low, you may have to add light and you will most likely need to use a tripod.

Keep your image simple, create the best possible composition. Have fun with it! let us know how you accomplished your image and what you used.

**Tips:** Compact cameras are great performers. Macro lenses (most expensive option) work great, but consider extension tubes or even reversing your lens. Another option: If you have the space, use a long lens.
